




2024-2025 JR. NBA 1st & 2nd GRADE RULES

The Basics

- 1. Game format 3 vs 3 or match what the opposing team has without exceeding 3.
- 2. Court half court
- 3. Officials coaches
- 4. Goal Height 8-foot
- 5. Ball Size Junior, 27.5"
- 6. Man-to-Man defense
- 7. Home team will start with the basketball
- 8. When a possession change of the basketball occurs, the offensive team must return it to the center circle, via dribble or pass, to be able to score. Take backs off a rebound, or stolen pass are "free", no stealing from the other team until ball is returned to center circle.



Timing

- 1. 32-minute game with four 8-minute quarters continuous clock.
 - a. 5-minute halftime
- 2. Mandatory substitutions will occur at the 4-minute mark of the quarters.
 - a. Clock will ONLY stop for substitutions or injury.
 - b. Every kid will play 16 minutes or two quarters of basketball.
- 3. One parent from the away team will oversee running the clock during the game.
 - a. Coaches will be in charge of asking for a volunteer.
 - b. Clock will stop at the halfway mark for substitutions.
- 4. Teams will be allowed 1 timeout per half.
 - a. Timeouts do not carry over into second half.

Scoring

- 1. Scoring will not be kept and there will be no overtime.
- 2. Free throws will not be shot. If a foul occurs, the team will maintain possession of ball, but return to the center circle to start the offense.

Offense

- 1. Ball must start in center circle every possession.
- 2. Traveling/double dribble will be at coaches' discretion, but it is encouraged to become stricter as the season progresses.
- 3. If team scores on offense, the ball will start in the center circle with the opposing team on offense.
- 4. Player dribbling is not allowed to back down opponent all the way into paint.
- 5. 10 second call is at coaches discretion, but players will need to pass if they hold onto the ball for an extended time close to 10 seconds.
- 6. No timeouts with the exception for teams playing in game of the week.

Defense

- 1. Defensive team must stay inside of 3-point line.
- 2. No on-ball stealing is allowed but passes may be stolen IF inside the 3-point line.
- 3. If a foul is committed, it is encouraged for coaches to teach their players, and the offensive team will return ball to the center circle to start offense.
- 4. A player can't foul out, but rough play will not be tolerated.
- 5. If player on defense rebounds a shot or steals a pass, they may dribble or pass it, but the ball must return to the center circle before they can score. "Free take-backs" are allowed during this possession change.

Game of The Week

- 1. Every team will have a game of the week.
- 2. Teams will be allowed 1 timeout/half and timeouts will not carry over.
- 3. The week leading up to the game of the week, teams will be introduced via social media.
- 4. Format will be full court 3vs3.
- 5. Coaches are allowed on the court, but a referee will be there to make calls.
- 6. Announcer will introduce both teams with music and lineup introductions.
- 7. Jump ball will determine possession.
 - a. Only the two kids jumping can be in the center circle.

- 8. Ball return to center circle will not take in effect if game is in full court unless: 1) start of quarter 2) out of timeout 3) dead ball, jump ball, or foul occurs
 - a. Ball must be taken out of bounds off a made basket
